The EMS applies to the activity of "Commercialization and brokerage of waste without storage." This environmental policy outlines the most significant principles guiding the Organization and its EMS and is communicated to all relevant interested parties, both internal and external to the company.

Leadership

Management is committed to ensuring the Organization's compliance with the system in order to continually improve its environmental performance, fully meet applicable compliance obligations, and achieve the set environmental objectives. It ensures that all necessary resources are allocated to the EMS and its processes. The commitment to preventing events that generate environmental impact is promoted primarily by management, which ensures the accountability of all company personnel by assigning roles and responsibilities and raising awareness of key environmental issues.

In addition, management recognizes the importance of the context in which it operates and analyzes internal and external factors that influence its processes and the EMS, as well as identifying interested parties and their needs and expectations.

The Organization also identifies the significant environmental aspects related to its processes and activities by adopting a life cycle approach. This analysis aims to set improvement objectives and monitor its environmental impacts, while also identifying specific mitigation actions required to reduce environmental impacts.

All of this serves as input to a risk and opportunity analysis and management process, leading to the definition of mitigation, prevention, and improvement measures.

Compliance with Obligations

For Ecotrade Spa, meeting compliance obligations—whether legally required or voluntarily adopted—is fundamental and essential for ensuring continuous improvement of its performance and EMS. Full compliance with documentation related to these obligations is ensured through periodic audits. All considered obligations are mapped and kept as recorded information.
